It also introduces basic quantitative methods used in research projects to develop functional knowledge and its application in procurement role. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS For entry to the Higher Certificate programme a candidate must: • Be over 23 years of age • Have at least three years appropriate work experience • Be working in procurement and supply management in the private or public sectors • Have five passes in the Leaving Certificate including Mathematics and English or an equivalent educational standard. As part of the application process, students are required to detail their work experience and to have this verified by their employer. Fees qualify for tax relief The fee includes: monthly tutorials, registration and examination fees, revision classes before examinations, technical seminars, access to online student community Moodle with all resources: study guides, detailed module descriptors, assessment guidelines, past and sample papers, online library. ASSESSMENTS The choice of assessment methods for each module will reflect the stated objectives, the learning outcomes and, the teaching methods employed. The assessment instruments will include: Module Assignments, Terminal Examinations, Learner Reflections, Integrative Assessment and Research Assignment. TUITION We offer a block learning approach that gives you the flexibility to study for your qualification without the need to attend weekly lectures. With our weekend tutorial sessions each month you can condense your lecture time without interfering with your busy lifestyle. You will still benefit from our extensive range of learning supports and will also have access to your tutors online. They are part of the IIPMM Honours Degree Programme and are designed with the busy professional in mind. These are great stand alone qualifications, but should you wish to progress, these programmes will enable you to enter the Institute's Higher Certificate. The modules completed at the certificate stage will count toward your Higher Certificate.
